Hallway	I am in the Red Zone (voices off). I greet others with a wave and a smile.	I walk directly to where I need to be.	I keep my hands, feet and objects to myself. I use quiet feet on the stairs and stay on the right side. I walk in a single file line on the right side.
Lunchroom	I use good manners. (please, thank you and excuse me) I raise my hand for assistance. I am in the Yellow Zone (quiet voices).	I keep my area clean. I eat my own food and respect other's personal space.	I face forward and stay seated with my feet under the table. I walk in a single file line.
Playground	Show respect for all students, adults, equipment and plants. I will use kind language and actions on the playground.	I will line up when recess is over. I will seek permission before leaving the playground. I will only take equipment outside that I placed in the class tub.	I will keep my hands and feet to myself. I will play safely and stay on the playground.
Bathroom	I respect others by keeping my feet on the floor and my hands to myself. I am in the Yellow Zone. (quiet voices)	I use the toilet appropriately and flush. I put my paper towels in the garbage can. I walk directly back to class.	I wash my hands. (2:10:10:2-2 pumps of soap, 10 seconds washing, 10 seconds rinsing, 2 paper towels)
Assembly	I enter and exit quietly. I keep my hands and feet to myself. I participate appropriately.	I leave everything in the classroom.	I sit flat on the floor.
Bus	I am in the Yellow zone (quiet). I follow directions of the bus driver.	I get on and off the bus promptly. I am in charge of all my belongings with me.	I keep my hands, feet and objects to myself. I sit in my seat and face forward. I walk to the bus.
Line-up Procedures	When I line up outside, I am in the Yellow Zone (quiet voices). When I enter the building I am in the Red Zone (voices off).	I will stay in my spot in the line and raise my hand if I need assistance. I will follow adult directions the first time.	I keep my hands, feet and property to myself. I walk facing forward when the line starts moving.
